# 2 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF 25.1.17

- 2.1 The research into Cistermiser costs is ongoing. ACTION: Clerk /FAO

#### 6 YEAR END ACCOUNTS 2016-17

- 6.1 The FAO presented the Bank Reconciliation 2016-17.
  She confirmed that there were 2 unpresented cheques for petty cash.
  The Committee **RESOLVED** to cancel these two Unity bank cheques and issue a new cheque for the total amount on the Nat West account dated in 2017-18.
- A 47p difference in the petty cash is to be corrected in the bank reconciliation. There is a difference of £36.84 in the Income/Expenditure report.

  The balance sheet shows a £7.22 discrepancy between Sage and the balance sheet. The Nat West bank charges are to be checked.
- 6.3 The Committee **RECOMMENDED** to Full Council the acceptance of the Year End Accounts for 2016-17, with the corrections noted in 6.2 above.
