**2.1** Ms Hobson gave an overview of WBC's role as a Lead Local Flood Authority. She spoke of the Local Flood Risk Strategy, the Register of Assets and the creation of Flood Action Groups.

Mr Napper spoke of the drainage issues affecting Hatch Farm Dairies and Winnersh in general and explained the positions of the Environment Agency and Thames Water within the overview of interested agencies.

Ms Hobson gave a presentation of WBC's strategy on flood management and contingency; including staffing, the objectives of the Local Flood Risk Strategy, emergency response, mapping, and Flood Action Groups.

The meeting discussed the best course for developing a FAG to suit the needs of Winnersh. Ms Hobson will send details of the National Flood Forum website.
