Minutes of the PLANNING COMMITTEE meeting held in the ALLNATT PAVILION on Tuesday 13 AUGUST 2019

PRESENT: Cllrs P Fishwick (Chairman) (ex officio), L Wooldridge (ex officio), B Krauze, P Bray, F Breedlove

- 1. Apologies for absence were received from Cllr C Taylor
- 2. Declarations of Interest: None received.
- 3. There were no matters arising from the draft minutes of the meeting of the 23 July 2019.
- 4. Public session: there were no members of the public present.
- 5. The committee considered the following applications and raised no objections:-

Planning Application Number: 191667

Site Address: 9 Wedderburn Close, Winnersh RG41 5NY

Proposal: Full retrospective planning for change of use of visual amenity land to private residential garden and the erection of a 1.8m fence.

Application Number: 191897

Site Address: 307 Reading Road, Winnersh RG41 5LR

Proposal: Householder application for the proposed single-story side/rear extension following demolition of existing rear conservatory, roof alteration to existing garage, first floor side/rear extensions including 2no. dormer extensions/roof alterations, internal alterations and changes to fenestration to existing dwelling.

Site Address: 1C Locksley Gardens, Winnersh RG41 5NZ

Proposal: Householder application for the proposed conversion of existing garage into habitable accommodation, internal alterations and changes to fenestration.

8. To receive an update from Cllr. Fishwick on the Arborfield and Barkham Neighbourhood Plan consultation

Cllr Fishwick informed the committee that he had read through the Arborfield and Barkham Neighbourhood Plan consultation and not found any comments to raise that would impact on the Winnersh Parish Council area. Other councillors on the committee had also read the document and were in agreement that no comments would be submitted.

9. To receive an update from Cllr. Fishwick on the Wokingham Local Plan.

Cllr Fishwick informed the committee that two additional sites had been added to the Local Plan Update as follows;

- 5WI016 is a small site for self-build of .14 hectares. Location adjacent to 9 Winnersh Gate Winnersh.
- 5WI017 is 1.1 hectares at Holmwood House next to the Walter Arms Bearwood Road Sindlesham.

A draft schedule of comments was discussed by the committee and it was agreed to submit these to Wokingham Borough Council (Appendix A)

10. To consider the key parking issues for Winnersh to help inform and influence the draft Wokingham Borough Council Parking Management Plan.

The committee discussed the draft Wokingham Borough Council Parking Management Plan and made comments in RED and agreed to submit these as the response of Winnersh Parish Council (Appendix B).

- 11. Correspondence: The following items were received and noted as follows;
 - 24 July 2019 email from Wokingham Borough Council Subject: Public Rights of Way Improvement Plan (2020-2030) Have Your Say.

Winnersh parish Council had submitted comments to an earlier draft Public Rights of Way Improvement Plan in March 2019 and would welcome reviewing the latest document. The Clerk to be asked to place this item on the next Planning Committee Agenda.

This item was discussed, and it was the view of this committee that councillors who sit on the Fuel Allotments Trust should be offered places.

12. Accounts: to approve the schedule of payments since the last meeting of Full Council (to be tabled at the meeting).

A schedule of payments, due since the last Full Council meeting (9 July 2019), was tabled and upon the proposal of Cllr Breedlove, seconded by Cllr Bray, the Parish Council **RESOLVED** to make payments totalling £10,887.55. Bank balances at 31 July 2019 were confirmed as £71,565.19 (Annex C).

13. Any other matters considered urgent by the Chairman.

Cllr Breedlove raised concern about the narrow footway on the B3030 King Street Lane between Bearwood Road and the M4 overbridge on the western side. Cllr Fishwick informed the committee that he had already raised this issue through the Borough Council online reporting system and with officers and the footway width had been improved by the Borough Council by cutting back the overgrown vegetation. However, further work was needed, and officers were aware of this, to remove the encroachment of the verge on the footway as well as additional cutting back of vegetation to 'claim back' the original footway width and make it safe for pedestrians.

Local Plan Update – additional sites in Winnersh

5WI016 - is a small site for self-build of .14 hectares. Location adjacent to 9 Winnersh Gate Winnersh.

Comments;

- Why is this small site is being put forward under the Local Plan Update, surely it could be dealt with under a Planning application?
- Concern is raised that this could be a 'back route' to access 5WI006 with a 2nd access road in addition to Maidensfield with the demolition of 8 or 9 Winnersh Gate.
- The site has poor vehicular access.
- The site has a significant contribution to the Local Plan.

5WI017 is 1.1 hectares at Holmwood House next to the Walter Arms Bearwood Road Sindlesham.

Comments;

- Although the parcel of land known as Holmwood falls outside of the Sindlesham Conservation Area that was designated on 2nd December 1993, the impact of any urbanisation would have a detrimental effect on the Conservation Area that surrounds three of its sides, with the picturesque cricket ground on the fourth side.
- The site is within the countryside and outside of the settlement area of Sindlesham.
- Sadler's Lane has poor access for any additional traffic.
- The existing access from Holmwood onto Bearwood Road is limited to minimal traffic movements and close to Sadler's Lane junction, and therefore not suitable for additional traffic generation.
- The site is not in an area to support sustainable transport, adding to additional traffic
 (congestion on already busy roads), poor air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions impacting
 on Climate Change.

The site has a significant number of trees that must be maintained.
